



Subject: Important Guidelines for Board Examinations (As per CBSE Instructions)

Dear Students

As informed earlier and practiced in pre board 1, CBSE has introduced changes in the structure of **Science** and **Social Science** question papers for Class X. All students must carefully read and follow the instructions given below to avoid any mistakes during Board examinations.

1. Structure of Question Papers

Science : The question paper will be divided into **three (03) sections**:

- **Section A – Biology**
- **Section B – Chemistry**
- **Section C – Physics**

Social Science : The question paper will be divided into **four (04) sections**:

- **Section A – History**
- **Section B – Geography**
- **Section C – Political Science**
- **Section D – Economics**

Students may refer to the sample papers on the CBSE Academic website or pre board 1 papers.

2. Important Instructions for Writing the Board Examination

1. **Students must divide their answer book into:**
 - **3 sections for Science, and**
 - **4 sections for Social Science,**clearly marking each section before writing answers.
2. **Answers must be written only in the space allotted** for that particular section.
3. **Answers of one section must not be written or mixed** with any other section.
4. **Mixed or misplaced answers will not be evaluated, and no marks will be awarded** for such responses.
5. Such mistakes will **not be corrected** even during verification or revaluation after the results are declared.

3. Instructions for Practice

All students must practice writing answers section-wise **before the Board examinations**. These instructions will also be implemented during the **Second Pre-Board examinations**. **Students must follow the above guidelines strictly to ensure that their answer books are evaluated correctly.**
