Greetings!

On the occasion of **Earth Day (22nd April)**, we are delighted to engage our young learners in joyful, hands-on activities inspired by our Indian ethos of “प्रकृति से प्रेम” (Love for Nature). Kindly find the class-wise activities below and support your child in preparing for the same.

1. Buds Nursery – धरती के दोस्त

Through this activity, students will learn what is good and what is bad for the Earth.

- Students will identify and segregate objects into those that are good for the Earth (like plants, water, soil) and those that are harmful (like plastic, garbage, and cutting trees).

Material will be provided by the school.

2. Petals LKG- प्रकृति स्पर्श (Touch & Feel Nature)

Our little explorers will connect with nature through sensory play.

- Children will touch and feel natural elements like leaves, soil, flowers and pebbles. They will collect these and create a simple Nature Collage.

Material will be provided by the school.

3. Sepals UKG– हरियाली कलाकार (Little Green Artists)

Children will express their understanding of nature through Clay Modelling.

- Clay modeling of nature elements like trees, flowers, sun, birds etc.

Material Required:

- *Clay will be provided by the school. Please send a labelled base (board/tray) to keep the clay models.*

4. Grade1– पत्थर पर प्रकृति Nature on Stones)

Students will bring nature to life through art.

- They will do Pebble painting based on the theme Nature (such as sun, birds, Mountains, fish etc.)

Material required:

- *Pebbles will be provided by the school. Please send water colours, brush, colour palette and rough cloth (Duster/Tissue).*

5. Grade 2– जल रक्षक (Save Water Crowns)

Students will learn about water conservation in a fun and creative way.

- Crown making activity (Save Water theme): Students will bring materials from home and assemble it in class.

Material required:

- *Fevicol will be provided by the school. Please send theme based decorative material, base material and rough cloth (Duster/Tissue).*
